Decending on to Waiting Participants	Participants/Instructor	Waiting Participants kept at a safe distance from the climbing wall face	1	2	2	Constant supervision, Barriers used as required
Loose Handholds	Participants/Instructor	Handholds checked prior to climbing wall use	1	3	3	
Decent Injury	Participant	Decent brief given to climbers prior to ascent	1	1	1	Training and supervision
Suspension Inury from Loose Jewelry	Participant	Participants requested to remove or secure loose jewelry	1	1	1	
Unsupervised use/ access	Participant	Restricted access when not in use. Wall lowered after daily session on multiple day bookings	2	1	2
